This position offers experience in both basic and clinical research in medical ultrasound and provides the candidate with a unique opportunity to be part of a highly energetic group working to translate research into clinical care.

The successful candidate will be expected to show initiative and creativity, to proactively develop his/her research interests and to work effectively with others toward shared goals. Candidates who seek a long-term academic career will have tremendous growth opportunities, access to committed mentors, and assistance in applying for career development and research grants. There will be many opportunities for mentorship from MIT and Harvard scientists working in close collaboration with MGH physicians and scientists.

Responsibilities:

The successful applicant will:

- Work collaboratively with a highly motivated and collegial team of physicians, clinical researchers, computer scientists, and engineers, to solve important medical problems in a world-class research facility.
- Have access to advanced computing facilities and an unparalleled community of basic and clinical scientists.
- Gain an understanding of key diseases, especially in the liver, thyroid, prostate, kidney, and breast.
- Collaboratively participate in and initiate projects, and work with and supervise other junior research fellows to initiate and design research studies.
- Further develop their expertise and ultimately their own research program in the Center.

Requirements:

- MD or MPH, preferred.
- Minimum of 2 years' experience in clinical research.
- Successful IRB and other research compliance duties clearly documented in prior job responsibilities.
- Demonstrated experience working with a PI or research group to develop and submit study proposals for funding; grant writing experience will be advantageous. A demonstrated record of publications is preferred.
- Excellent communication skills in written and verbal English.
- Strong leadership skills
- Qualified candidates should be self-motivated and possess the ability to work independently and collaboratively.
