- Commit to mentoring a student
 - High School 8 weeks
 - College 12 weeks
 - Dates: May 28 (college) or June 17 (high school) to August 9
- Provide an appropriate research project, space, resources, and daily mentorship
- Oversee student progress on:
 - Learning Plan
 - Abstract
 - Scientific Presentation
 - Literature Review
- Attend mandatory mentor orientation and participate in mid-summer check-ins
